P. 2 - repetition imagery, hyperbole/idiom

The word "I" repeated 6x

I sit on her squishy couch

my mouth sealed shut my eyes burning holes

The word "my" repeated 2x

P. 3 - simile, onomatopoeia

Sounds like a kung fu move. I adjudicated you in your face! HI-YA

P. 4. - metaphor, repetition, personification

Congrats, James, you have graduated and are now a complete Tool.

The phrase "Do you hear me" repeated 3x

A **personal journal** is very crowded **With so many eyes**.

P. 5 - repetition, simile, hyperbole, alliteration

The phrase "every day" repeated 2x

It's pretty simple. **Like a court-ordered cage,**with a mom-shaped lock.

Or they'll throw you in juvie so fast your head will spin As if my head isn't already spinning.

On that day, weeks ago, I'd lost my head. Everything foggy and frosty,

P. 8 - hyperbole, imagery

Nine months ago. Feels like nine years.

P. 9 - repetition

Then the phone rang n the pitch-dark night

The word "bad" repeated 2x

P. 10 - repetition

The words "brand new" repeated 2x The word "anything" repeated 2x P. 11 The word "understand" repeated 3x The word "day" repeated 2x The word "head" repeated 2x The word "hole" repeated 2x The phrase "Levi's neck" repeated 2x P. 12 - simile, imagery, hyperbole, metaphor, repetition I guess the trach is like a plastic nostril in Levi's neck It has all the gross stuff that nostrils have: slippery boogers and slime and gunk And when he sneezes, these snot bullets shoot out. So, yeah. It's a plastic nostril in your neck. The words "does it" repeated 2x P. 13 - repetition, simile, hyperbole The word "choke/chokes" repeated 2x When he chokes we use the suction machine and it is so loud like a jackhammer drinking a Slurpee I told him I was getting a tracking device on my ankle and if I leave the house it will blow my whole leg off P. 14 - repetition

P. 15 - repetition
The word "about" repeated 2x
The word "know/knows" repeated 2x
The word "But" repeated 2x
P. 16 - repetition, rhyme
The words "at all" repeated 2x
That <b>day</b> . Always in my head. Won't go <b>away</b> .
P. 17 - Idiom
My brain went white.
P. 19 - onomatopoeia
Even when the pharmacy door ding-dinged
P. 20 - imagery, simile, repetition
slamming the journal shut almost as hard as my heart slamming into my ribs
The sentence "I'm just a kid" repeated 2x
P. 21 - repetition, rhyme, hyperbole/idiom
The word "words/word" repeated 3x
Trach is one. You remember that one, right?

It rhymes with <b>brake</b> and <b>take</b> .
He hangs on the wedge so his trach stays unobstructed.  That sentence is my world now. (has your entire attention)
The word "world" repeated 3x
The word " <b>normal</b> " repeated 3x
P. 22- repetition
The word "even" repeated 2x
The word "hands" repeated 2x
The word "fractions" repeated 2x
P. 23- repetition, imagery
The words "four sisters" repeated 2x
The words "house/houses" repeated 3x
Even with Levi's jackhammer suction machine
But they have these <b>fuzzy</b> , <b>soft heads</b> They have <b>slurpy smiles</b> .
The words "slurpy smiles" repeated 2x
P. 24 - repetition
The words "babies/baby" repeated 3x
P. 25 - idiom, repetition
I don't feel like <b>I've broken through anything</b> , though. Really.
Maybe some things have broken through me.
The word "bad" repeated 2x
The word " <b>no</b> " repeated 3x

P. 26 - idiom

Timothy we are dead if we get caught.

P. 27 - onomatopoeia

And so you sort of suck in air and make a **clacking** noise.

P. 28 -- repetition

Mac and cheese for dinner again peanut butter but no bread Again powdered milk in stale cereal again

going to sleep hungry

again

P. 37 - repetition

milk milk milk more more more more milk more milk more milk

P. 39 - repetition

I will never do it again. You must know that, James.

I will never do it again.

Even though sometimes I wonder just a tiny wonder a little piece of dust-size wonder miniature wonder

What if...

What if I had one more magic wallet...

The wonder is very tiny

P. 41 - metaphor, repetition

wrapped in a blanket
so that his arms and legs can't move
so that you can bend his neck over a towel
so that you can pull the tube from his neck

P. 43 - hyperbole, Simile

When I go to Jose's house it's like another dimension

P. 44 - imagery, onomatopoeia

Beeping alarms, or screeching sisters?

Jose's dad bought a car. It's a car he says used to be cool. **Now it looks like a giant rusted turtle** with no guts inside

P. 45 - repetition

I imagine it on fire.
I imagine it on fire in an ocean of lava with fireproof sharks circling it.
I imagine it on fire in an ocean of lava with fireproof sharks circling it and shooting it with laser eyes.

P. 46 - alliteration, imagery, hyperbole, simile

You know those super sunny days?
The ones that come out of nowhere,
where every slant of sunshine
bursts through the window blinds
warming up whatever they touch
not too hot
but just right
and you can feel the sun burning your face
burning in a good way
Like if you could stand inside fireworks
and not get burned?

P. 47 - imagery, simile

This fresh-squeezed orange juice left on the porch with a box of chocolate doughnuts with a bag of breakfast tacos with fiery red salsa is making the insides of my mouth feel Just like those fireworks Just like the slant of sunshine

P. 48 - hyperbole, simile, repetition

You don't have to always jump down my throat trying to snatch away my words like they are bombs about to tear the world apart.

P. 50 - idiom, hyperbole, imagery, repetition

## I can almost see the smoke shooting from his ears

P. 53 - metaphor, hyperbole, imagery (pain of sickness), repetition

There are sharks in my throat.

Tiny sharks.

With supersharp teeth.

With laser eyes.

They are destroying my **throat**.

There are trolls in my head.

Evil trolls.

With superheavy hammers.

With thundering fists.

They are destroying my head.

From the inside out.

It's possible I am dying.

Infected with sharks and trolls.

P. 54 - onomatopoeia, hyperbole, repetition

The nurse makes a **pshhh** noise.

You're about to get murdered with words!

listening, listening, listening

You don't touch the go-bag. You don't go near the go-bag. The go-bag is perfection. It's like a tiny hospital in an ugly red duffel.

P. 56 - onomatopoeia, repetition

#### Dun dun duuuuuuuuuun.

Sometimes there's a tsk-ing noise

Why are **you** sorry, ugly lady at the grocery store? Did **you** give Levi a messed-up airway? Did **you** give him a trach?

That's the one thing I like about you, James.
Maybe the only thing.
You see Levi all the time.
And you never say you're sorry.

you soft-punch his tiny baby shoulder

If your mom is overwhelmed, if there isn't enough food if it's not safe for Levi,

P. 60 - repetition

At least you can hate your dad to his face.

At least you have time to spend together.

At least your sisters breathe through their noses.

At least you have a decent lunch

### You'd think maybe I have the black plague

the way Mrs. B sucked in her breath When she saw me this morning.

Page 62 - hyperbole

I've been trying to stay upstairs.

Keeping my germs in their own galaxy, far, far away.

Page 63 - metaphor

I staggered downstairs.

The zombie formerly known as Timothy.

Page 64 - repetition

The word **brother** repeated 5x

The word "I" repeated 4x

The word "folded" repeated 2xThe word "patted" repeated 2x

The word "**He**" repeated 5x

The line "please don't have him be getting sick" repeated 5x

Sometimes I shake

like a little earthquake that is only inside of me.

The phrase "It happens when I talk about" repeated 2x

The phrase "It happens when I think about" repeated 2x

Page 67 - repetition

The phrase "trust me" repeated 2x

Page 68 - simile, alliteration

It was so nice, I could have stayed that way all day and all night just stuck there on that couch anchored still

Safe

looking like a complete dummy

Even with all of the washing and the hand sanitizer and wearing a mask

like a doctor

P. 69 repetition, hyperbole

The word "plus" repeated 2x

The sentence "That's all it takes to get to the hospital" repeated 2x

That's all it takes to get to the hospital.

Forever or ten minutes?

Sometimes they're the same, aren't they?

P. 69 repetition, onomatopoeia, imagery, hyperbole

The word "**running**" repeated 2x

Slap slap slap

Her bare feet, the hallway empty
On the <b>speeding gurney</b>
Holding the ambu bag over his trach
Squeezing, squeezing, squeezing
The sign shouted INTENSIVE CARE in all caps
P. 71 - hyperbole, simile, repetition
All of our energy had been sucked away through the doors at the end of the hall
And Mom cried on my shoulder
and she made noises l've never heard before like an animal in a trap, maybe
The word " <b>hear</b> " repeated 2x
The word " <b>anything</b> " repeated 2x
Only those shouting words on the doors INTENSIVE CARE INTENSIVE CARE
and we were the only two people in the world sitting in that hallway
The word " <b>floor</b> " repeated 2x
P. 72 idiom / hyperbole, onompatopoeia
