

Notes from the Nurse

IS THERE A LOUSE IN YOUR HOUSE?!

What to Look For

- Persistent itching of the scalp.
- Teardrop shaped specks close to your child's scalp that don't move when flicked.
- Elongated insects about 1/8-inch-long that are grayish-white with dark margins.
- You will see nits (louse's egg). Nits are 1/16 inch, teardrop-shaped and vary from yellowish-brown to white. They cannot be washed out or brushed out of hair with out special shampoo.

How You Get It

- Close personal contact with another individual who has lice.
- Sharing combs, brushes, hats, caps, or coats.
- Co-mingling of items such as hats, coats, blankets, scarves, or stuffed animals that might have lice on them.

Important to Remember

- Students or families who have lice are NOT unclean. Anyone can become infected with lice.
- Immediately notify the nurse and school
 if your child has lice or you suspect they
 do so they are aware. This allows them
 the chance to check for any others that
 might have it.

Delays and Closings

Due to weather conditions during the winter months, it is sometimes necessary to delay the opening of school, dismiss school early, or to cancel school for the day. Please note the following modified kindergarten schedule should a delay occur:

A modified kindergarten schedule does not impact afternoon kindergarten students.

There **is NO** morning KAP when a two-hour delay is called. There **is NO** afternoon KAP when there is an early dismissal.

Please note breakfast will NOT be served on days with 2 hour delays.

Hillside Elementary will have their Kindergarten Registration on April 7th in the afternoon. Appointments are necessary so please be sure to call Hillside Office at 774-1321 for more information.

To be admitted to kindergarten, children must be at least five (5) years of age before October 1, 2016, possess an official birth certificate and proper immunization records. Students registering for first grade must be six (6) years of age prior to October 1, 2016.
