In the Classroom

What are we learning?

<u>Writing</u>

 Our authors are beginning a new unit on opinion writing. Students will learn the difference between facts and opinions, as well as how to back up their opinion with reasons and evidence.

<u>Math</u>

 Our mathematicians are continuing to work on word problems and practicing addition and subtraction in expanded form.

<u>Science</u>

 Our scientists are learning about how sound is made, how it travels, and how we hear it.

<u>Literacy</u>

 Our readers will be practicing reading harder, more complex texts while using multiple strategies to help them read for understanding.

Reminders:

- Talk to your child about their reading level! The goal for this point in second grade is level K-L. They should know their level and be able to talk about it!
- It is mandatory that your child is in school uniform every day.
