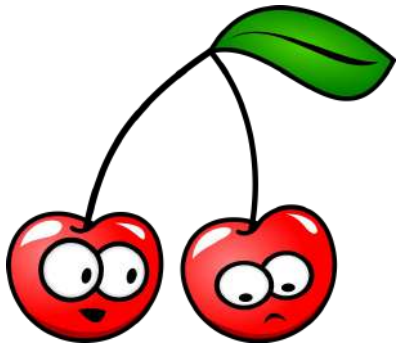

We know Valentine’s Day brought lots of delicious desserts but here is an idea for a yummy healthy alternative.

- Sour Cherry Sorbet**
3 cups frozen pitted tart cherries
1 cup sugar
1/3 cup grape juice
1/2 teaspoon almond extract
1/2 teaspoon salt
- Directions*
1. Place cherries in a food processor; cover and process until pureed. Add remaining ingredients; cover and pulse until blended. Transfer puree to a freezer container.
2. Freeze 1 hour or until edges begin to firm; stir. Freeze 2 hours longer or until firm.
3. Just before serving, transfer to a blender food processor; cover and process 2-3 minutes or until smooth.
Yield: 6 servings. 175 calories

This delicious snack is quite healthy, but remember; desserts are a sometimes snack. Eat them only sometimes!
