Winston-Salem State University Charlotte-QC Rams Alumni Chapter Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: 1. The scholarship is limited to graduating seniors enrolled in Mecklenburg, and Union County Schools. 2. The student's application will not be considered if he/she has received a full or partial scholarship from Winston-Salem State University that covers tuition, books, fees, room, and board. The scholarship committee reserves the right to verify this information with the university directly. 3. Graduation from an accredited high school or will have graduated from such school prior to the enrollment date of the fall semester of the year for which selection is made. 4. The recipient must have a **cumulative weighted high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.8** or higher. 5. The recipient is required to volunteer in the Charlotte/QC Rams Chapter Golf Tournament. The tournament is TBD.

The application must be postmarked by **Friday, April 1, 2022** to be considered for this year's award.

CGCS-Bernard Harris Math and Science Scholarships Program

The Council of the Great City Schools is partnering with Dr. Bernard Harris to offer the CGCS-Bernard Harris Math and Science Scholarships Program for high school seniors who are majoring in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math).

Named after former astronaut, physician and businessman Bernard Harris, who was the first African American to walk in space, the scholarships are available to 2022 graduating seniors in urban school districts represented by the Council. Four **\$5,000** scholarships for two males and two females each will be awarded to two African American and two Hispanic seniors pursuing studies in STEM-related fields in college next fall.

To apply for the 2022 scholarship, the application must be submitted online by **May 6, 2022**.

The Bridge Scholarship will be presented annually to the individual who can best present his or her need for financial aid in order to achieve a specific goal or participate in a particular program at any accredited college or university in the United States of America. There are no minimal requirements, academic, athletic or extracurricular; however, each applicant must be accepted to their chosen institution prior to the award of any financial aid. Applicants must present their intentions in a clear, concise and cogent manner what their goals are for the upcoming four-year period, how they plan achieve those goals.

The Charlotte Metro Area Relocation Council Scholarship

The Charlotte Metro Area Relocation Council is a non-profit organization that brings together corporations and relocation service providers in and around Charlotte for the primary purpose of providing educational information and current industry updates to its members. As part of our commitment to Relocation, CMARC has developed a scholarship program for current high school seniors who have relocated into the Charlotte area sometime between grades 9 (after 8th grade graduation) and 12. The one-time award of \$1,000 will be presented to one Charlotte area high school senior this year. The award will be sent to the college that the student will be attending to assist with tuition, etc.

CMARC will select scholarship winners based on the strength of their total package. The student will be evaluated on academic performance, extra-curricular activities and on their response to an essay addressing the challenges associated with relocating to a new area and a new high school. All applications must be submitted by **March 15th** to have time to evaluate them and select.

Changing Lives Together Foundation - Jordan Brigman Memorial Scholarship

The CLT Foundation will assist local high school graduates with financial grants to help them achieve this dream. We believe in the power of education and we believe in the kids of our community, and by providing these opportunities we believe we can help change lives. Scholarships will start at \$2,500/year per recipient and go up to \$10,000/year and be paid directly to the school they are attending.

Amount: Multiple awards, from \$2,500 - \$10,000 per award. One-year award but winners are eligible to re-apply each year. Deadline: **April 8, 2022.**

Criteria: Any applicant who has life altering medical (physical, intellectual, or mental) conditions or special medical needs. Scholarship awards are based on academic achievement, character, financial need, and degree of impact to life based on their life altering condition.

- Criteria:
1. Applicant is required to list other financial aid that has been applied for and/or received.
 2. Applicant must possess a 2.5 or above cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) unweighted.
 3. Applicant must attend a school in Mecklenburg County.
 4. Applicant must submit an official high school transcript and a letter of acceptance from a 4- Year college/university.
 5. Applicant must submit three (3) letters of recommendation. At least one of the recommendations must come from a community leader, a school professional and the applicant's choice.
 6. Applicant must submit a current, professional looking picture that contains only the applicant.
 7. Application must be postmarked by April 11, 2022 in order to be considered.
 8. Applicant(s) selected to receive the scholarship(s) will be chosen by May 2, 2022 and recipient name(s) will be posted on the Zetas of Charlotte website www.zetasofcharlotte.org
 9. Monies received from the scholarship will be mailed directly to the scholarship recipient(s) upon receipt of required documentation of enrollment.
 10. Scholarship will be a one-time payment to the recipient (s).
