## <u>Academic Achievement</u>

If you remember, FAST is a testing screener for our K-6 students in Math and Literacy. Once again, I am happy to report that our students and staff did another outstanding job. Take a look at these three stats:

- Our percent proficient rates for **both Literacy and Math increased** between Fall 2023 and Winter 2024.
- Our percent proficient rate for Literacy was 7% <u>higher</u> than the AEA and state of Iowa.
- Our percent proficient rate for Math was 11% <u>higher</u> than the AEA and 13% <u>higher</u> than the state of Iowa.

As the superintendent, I am definitely pleased with the results, and I am proud of our students and staff for this achievement.
