<u>Ohio Farm Bureau Scholarships</u> - Offers several scholarships. All are based on school and community activities, require 2.5 GPA, letters of recommendation, and an essay. Applications are available on-line at <u>www.ofbf.org/foundation</u> then click on scholarships. Application is available January 1, and deadlines vary by scholarship.

<u>Columbus Foundation Scholarships</u> – Administers over 200 scholarships. Many are open to Fairfield County students. Go to <u>www.columbusfoundation.org/scholarships</u>. Requirements, amounts and deadlines vary. Application window opens January 1.

Builders Exchange Scholarships - Awards can be up to \$4,000, and are for students planning to pursue a construction-related education (incl. architecture, landscaping, engineering, project management, and others). Award is based on need, recommendations, academics and activities, field of study, and student's potential impact on the construction industry. <u>OSU LGBTQ Alumni Society Scholarship</u> – Group offers several scholarships to graduating seniors who will attend OSU (main campus or branch), and who have demonstrated involvement and dedication to the LGBTQ or HIV/AIDS communities. Application and additional information is available at <u>www.scarletandgay.com</u>, click on "Scholarships". Application deadline is <u>February 21.</u>

<u>AAA Safety Patrol Grant</u> – One grant of \$1,000, and four of \$250, to be awarded to graduating seniors who once served as members of the AAA School Safety Patrol. Based on academic record, safety patrol experience, activities, references and essay. Applications are available in the Guidance Office. Application deadline is <u>February 28.</u>

<u>Cordle Cares Foundation Scholarship</u> – Will award \$1,000 to a Fairfield County high school senior based on academics, community service, references and essays. Must be submitted online. <u>American Chemical Society Scholars Program</u> - Scholarships of up to \$5,000 per year are available to students planning to enter the fields of chemistry and other related fields. A list of eligible majors is available on the website. Applicants must be of African American, Hispanic/Latino, or American Indian descent. Requires 3.0 GPA, and is based upon financial need.
