#### **SOME GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING TO SCHOLARSHIPS:**

The application form is the only contact you have with the Scholarship Committee, so make it an impressive one!

- 1. Please print clearly in black or blue ink when completing all of your paper applications.
- 2. Check to be sure that the donor's criteria match your qualifications.
- 3. Supply all additional pieces of information requested: transcript, reference letter(s), class rank, financial aid form, etc. Always hand your scholarship applications in complete with all materials requested. Incomplete applications may not be considered by donors.
- 4. Spend extra time in developing your personal statement about why you're applying for a scholarship. The scholarship committees read these carefully and in many cases, this is the major factor in their decision. Make the statement as clear, direct and concise as possible. Reasons such as other siblings in college, single parent expenses, medical or living expenses, etc. can be given.
- 5. Remember scholarship application packets are a reflection of who you are, make them neat, complete and yes this is the time to brag about yourself. Sometimes telling something interesting or different about you makes you stand out next to another application. **Think outside the box!**
- 6. Should you receive a scholarship, a thank you letter expressing your appreciation should always be sent to the granting organization as soon as possible. I can supply you with contact information.
- 7. There are no guarantees that students will receive the scholarship money they feel they need. You are advised to have discussions with your parents about projected funds for college, so that you will be aware of monies available from the family, should adequate financial aid not be forthcoming.

\*Please be sure that all of the information you provide on your application is accurate. Please be aware that donors may choose to take back awarded scholarships if they find your information invalid.

# **BHS Scholarships (Using the BHS Application)**

- An application is included with this booklet. When filling out the application, please
  print clearly in black or blue ink all the needed information. Some of the information is
  the same for each scholarship you are applying for, complete that information prior to
  making your copies then go back and complete each individual application for each of
  the scholarships you are applying for.
- You can also download the application via the BHS website: www.barnstable.k12.ma.us/bhs/guidance where a template is available. Provide one for each scholarship you are applying for.
- Obtain one unofficial copy of your transcript from your counselor's administrative
  assistant and also include one letter of recommendation of your choice and staple
  them both to the back of each individual application. You can make copies of the
  transcripts and letters of recommendation for this purpose. Please do not put any
  applications in envelopes. This includes transcripts and letters of recommendation, no
  envelopes at all! I will not accept them turned in this way. I need each individual
  scholarship application packet stapled together when turned in, no paperclips please
  just staples.
- Hand completed applications in to Mrs. McDonald in the School Counseling Office Room 2112 no later than March 13, 2015 by 2:00 PM. No late applications will be accepted. You can turn them in prior to March 13<sup>th</sup> if you complete them earlier.

### The BHS Scholarships are as follows:

- **Sean Allen Memorial Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who has a disability and will be seeking to further his or her education or for a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing a degree and career dedicated to serving people with disabilities. One scholarship of \$2500 will be awarded.
- Town of Barnstable Disability Commission Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who has a documented disability, but they do not have to be on an IEP and will be pursuing his/her education beyond high school. You must be a resident of the Town of Barnstable. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.
- James M. Dunn Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who has overcome obstacles on the road to achieving academic success and has done so with perseverance, dedication, and a positive attitude. It is someone who has shown an understanding of and appreciation for others' differences. This student will be pursuing his/her education at an accredited college. One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded. \*Please write a short essay about why you feel you are deserving of this scholarship.
- Marjorie and Norman Ferguson Memorial Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who shows strong academic achievement, motivation to succeed, financial need and will be pursuing his/her education. Up to six scholarships will be awarded totaling \$3000.
- **First Citizens' Federal Credit Union Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education that shows academic achievement and community involvement. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.
- **Grand Prix Driving School Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who is a responsible student who takes driving seriously and does not believe in drinking and driving or texting and driving. One scholarship of \$200 will be awarded.
- Carl G. Hallgren Memorial Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who is a "worthy" student, who shows strong academic achievement, who will be pursuing his/her education and has financial need. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1500.
- **Doris Eldridge Harlow Cosmetology Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be entering a non-degree granting trade or technical school preference will be given to students pursuing a hairdressing career. Applicants need a positive attitude and two letters of recommendation will be required with the application. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1500.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Haley's Way" Memorial Scholarship Applicants should be BHS graduating seniors who will be pursuing their education at a college or university in the fall of 2015, who maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better, who always give their all, who always work to their fullest capacity and maintain a positive attitude no matter what circumstances life has given them. One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded.

- The Honey Dew Donuts Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who has a B- or better GPA, who will be attending a four year college in the fall and participates in local community activities and charities. One scholarship of \$250 will be awarded.
- **HUB International Insurance Agency Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who is planning to attend a four-year college or university and will be pursuing a career in Business. One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded.
- **John F. Kennedy Memorial Trust Fund Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who has demonstrated citizenship, scholarship, character, leadership, cooperation, seriousness of purpose, financial need and the promise of future success in his or her scholastic and other endeavors. The top three finalists will be interviewed. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$2000.
- **Marion Jordan Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education in music. Preference will be given to students pursuing a career to educate school children in music. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500.
- **George H. Lusk Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior whose personal behavior has been exemplary and who desires to pursue further education at a recognized institution of higher learning. Students who plan on attending Cape Cod Community College will receive special consideration. Two scholarships of \$500 will be awarded.
- **Robert F. Scudder Memorial Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be attending the Massachusetts Maritime Academy as a freshman. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1500.
- **Harriet E. Towle Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education in a medical profession. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500.
- Advocates for a Community College Education Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who
  has an academic record of improved grades through high school, who demonstrates financial need,
  who has been accepted and will attend Cape Cod Community College in the fall of 2015. One to four
  scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$4000 over 4 semesters.
- Barnstable Association for Recreational Shellfishing Scholarship "BARS" For a BHS graduating senior who plans on pursuing a career in Marine Biology, Estuarine Science, Oceanography or Marine Environmental Science, display a special interest/aptitude for Marine and/or Environmental studies, must have a GPA of at least a 3.0 or above, have financial need, show community involvement and must be a full time Barnstable County resident. Three scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded.

- Firefighter Ron Beals Memorial Scholarship including Tracy Beals For BHS graduating seniors of families of Town of Barnstable Fire Fighters, past and present, who are planning on pursuing his/her education fulltime at a college or technical school. Scholarships are based on need. First preference will be given to Barnstable Fire District. Second preference will be given to Centerville, Osterville, Marstons Mills Fire District. All others to follow. Three scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$750. Checks will be mailed to the parents of the student (and/or the student) after the successful completion of their 1<sup>st</sup> semester with at least a 2.0 GPA.
- **BHS Class of "77" Memorial Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who is planning on attending Cape Cod Community College in the fall of 2015 and has a high school GPA of 3.0. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500.
- The "Matty B" Red Raider Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who demonstrates significant participation, contribution, and involvement with the special needs community. One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded.
  - Please include with your application, on a separate piece of paper describing your involvement with the special needs community and how it helped you develop as a person. (250 words)
- Barnstable Police Aselton Scholarship (In memory of Michael Aselton) Applicants should be BHS graduating seniors who will be pursuing a career in Criminal Justice or Fire Science (specific). This must be listed as your major in college and courses must be taken in your major in your first term. Ten scholarships of \$1500 will be awarded.
- The "Class of 2009" Dean Boger Memorial Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education at a 2 or 4 year college or university, who has displayed a strong work ethic at Barnstable High School and has been involved in his/her community. Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500 each.
- Fair Acres Country Day School Alumni Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who plans to attend a 2 or 4 year college in the fall of 2015, are in good academic standing and who attended Fair Acres for preschool and/or kindergarten. Two scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded.
- Four Seas Ice Cream Randall Mark Warren Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who is
  pursuing their education at a four year college or university. Four to five scholarships will be
  awarded and the amount varies.
- Four Seas Ice Cream Richard "Dick" Warren Art Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who will be continuing their education at a four year school for dance, music, arts or graphic design. One scholarship will be awarded and the amount varies each year.
- Cathy Fraser Scholarship Fund For a BHS graduating senior who is planning on pursuing his/her education at a two or four year institution and is in need of financial assistance. Four scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.

- The Annual Ken Ballou Memorial Santuit and Cotuit Historical Society Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who has above average academic grades, strong College Board scores, participates in school and community activities, including part-time work, has financial need and who will be attending college in the fall of 2015. One scholarship of \$2000 will be awarded.
- **William A. Jones, Jr. Memorial Scholarship** For BHS graduating seniors who are living in the Barnstable Village/Cummaquid area fire district, who have financial need and plan to attend college in the fall. Seniors who live in a family of a firefighter in this district will have preference. Up to two scholarships of \$500 will be awarded.
- **Kiwanis Club of Hyannis Raymond Dubois Scholarship -** For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education. Preference will be given to Key Club members. This scholarship is given in honor and memory of Glenna Kohl. One scholarship will be given in the amount of \$1000.
- **Liberty Hall Club of Marstons Mills, Inc.** For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education and is a resident of the village of Marstons Mills. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500.
- Osterville Garden Club For a BHS graduating senior who will be going to college to pursue a career in marine biology, oceanography, landscape, green energy, conservation, horticulture, environmental sciences and related fields. One to four scholarships will be awarded and the amounts vary.
- Osterville Men's Club Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who will be pursuing his/her education. The applicant must have financial need and demonstrate character and leadership. The top ten finalists will be interviewed in the School Counseling Office at a later date. Three scholarships of \$5000 will be awarded.
- **Poyant Family Scholarship** For a BHS graduating senior who will be continuing their education at a four year college or university and who shows scholarship, character and participates in community service. One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded.
- Rotary Club of Hyannis Scholarship For a BHS graduating senior who is a Barnstable County resident. The applicant must have good academic standing, participate in extracurricular activities, community service and have financial need. The top twelve finalists will be interviewed in the School Counseling Office. They will be awarding eight scholarships in the amount of \$1500.

# **The Cape Cod Association Scholarship:**

- **Criteria**: This scholarship is for graduating high school students and continuing college students who were born on Cape Cod or the Islands and who presently reside on Cape Cod or the Islands (Barnstable, Nantucket or Dukes counties) who plan to/or attend an accredited college, university, or technical school. In addition, Cape Cod heritage, academic merit, financial need, and extracurricular involvement are weighed heavily when considering applications. The Association offers this scholarship to graduating high school seniors and college students for up to four years of an undergraduate program; however students must reapply every year.
- **How to Apply**: The application process is **online** for the Cape Cod Association Scholarship. To apply go to their website at www.capecodassoc.org.
- Amount of Award: The number of scholarships awarded and the amounts vary each year.
- **Deadline**: Postmark deadline is midnight on April 1, 2015 for new applicants.

#### **Kaitlin M. Silk Memorial Scholarship:**

awarded to two-four graduating seniors from Barnstable High School; one or two female students planning to pursue a degree in a health related field; and one or two students who played on the BHS field hockey team. All students will have demonstrated behavior that is consistent with Kaitlin's energy and her spirit to help others in need.
