

NAMING OF FACILITIES

An Ad Hoc committee will be created by the Board when they deem it necessary to name a school facility or part of a facility under their jurisdiction.

The Board will notify the public of the creation of this committee asking for volunteers to serve.

The committee members may consist of: Board members, parents, students, members of the general public and/or be made up of a project building committee.

The chairman of the Board will appoint said committee and charge that committee using the following guidelines:

CHARGE: The committee shall be charged to request public input for ideas and rationale for naming an identified facility and bringing forward at least one suggestion to the Board within a given time frame.

TIME FRAME: At the time the Board decides to create this committee, they will determine a time line for completion.

The committee will publicize a request for members of the Goffstown community to submit naming ideas to the committee c/o the SAU office by a given deadline. The submitted ideas may be accompanied by a brief statement supporting their suggestion.

The Board prefers that facilities, or parts of facilities, be named to reflect geographic location or to commemorate an historic event or concept.
