

## Chesapeake Boat Trip, CBGS Juniors, Fall 2013

This will be a field study of Chesapeake Bay ecology aboard the *Bay Quest* on the Coan and Potomac Rivers. We will run chemical and physical tests on water samples, tow plankton nets and a large trawling net, tong for oysters, pull crab pots, and so on. We may also have a chance to visit an oyster aquaculture operation. We will be on the trip from 8:00 – 5:00.
