# **Quarter Events Assignment**

### **Purpose**

To get each student out of the classroom and to be able to properly find and cover events in the local community. This allows for the freedom of choosing what the student wants to film. Your videos will be shown to both the school and the community, either through meetings or social media.

## In the Industry

When you're working either freelance or for a company, be it Broadcast or Event Videographer, you will sometimes need to cover events that you typically would not normally film. There are plenty of filmmakers who have become famous for filming at sporting events or events in the community.

#### What You Need to Film

The purpose of this ongoing assignment is to provide films back to our community: Flowing Wells High School. To do so any and all events are to be connected to Flowing Wells School District.

Things that count: Sports games, Lover's Leap, Pep Assemblies, Classroom Activities(Science Labs, etc), Film Club requests, Dances, and other things.

Things that will not count: Your Sister's Baby Shower, Your Bro's Sweet Skateboarding Skills, etc

This can be achieved during school hours, not just after school. When in doubt ask Mr. Nistas.

#### Film Requirements

Students will need to cover an event and be able to put it together into a **30-60** second video, with music underneath. You will need to do at least two of the basic formula's for sequencing:

Long Shot | Medium Shot | Close Up | Re-establishing Shot
You will have a title screen at the beginning of the project with your information and a two
sentence description of the event. Between that and the start of the film as well as the end of
the film you will need two seconds of black screen. Music should begin and end during the
black screen. The title screen and the black screen will not count towards your time
requirements. Clips should be around 3-7 seconds only(Unless you can justify longer).

#### When is the project due?

This project is ongoing and will be due at the end of each month(You are able to film an event up until the last day of the month and then must have it turned in by the next school day). Check with Mr. Nistas on the required amount of events you'll need to cover. You are always able to turn in events sooner rather than later.
