KEYSTONE EXAM TESTING

Students who are scheduled to take one or more Keystone Exams will receive a separate letter with specific testing information. The Algebra, Literature, and Biology Keystone Exams will be administered on January 7th, 8th, and 9th, 2025. Only students taking a Keystone Exam will report to school. **Testing students will remain in school for the entire day.** All other students will not report to school. Students in grade 12 **do not** need to take Keystone exams. Please refer to the information below for the schedule after testing.

EXAMINATIONS WILL BE GIVEN IN THE REGULAR CLASSROOM

THE SECOND SEMESTER OFFICIALLY BEGINS ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 23RD.

FOR STUDENTS: The final examination schedule will follow the schedule of classes that you pursued during the first semester. The exception is that the four (4) blocks will be spread over two (2) days. Final examinations will be given in the following areas: English, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, World Languages, Business, and Health. In these subjects, all pupils will take examinations. Examinations will be administered in your regular classroom, supervised by the classroom instructor or an instructor designated by the administration.

THE ONLY EXCUSE ACCEPTED FOR FAILURE TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION IS AN EXCUSE FROM A DOCTOR OR THE ADMINISTRATION.

AUTHORIZED STUDENT AREAS DURING EXAMS: During the examination periods, no students are to be in the halls or main lobby areas of the school. If you are not scheduled for an examination and must be at Freedom High School because of transportation constraints, you are to report to the cafeteria. Once you report to the cafeteria, you are to remain there until the end of the period.

TRANSPORTATION: During the final examination period, the school buses will run at their regular times in the morning and at 12:00 PM on January 17 & 21, 2025. There will be no scheduled bus service on Wednesday, January 22, 2025. Students who need to make up exams on Wednesday should arrange personal transportation. There will be no buses to take students home after the first examination session on each exam day.

SNOW DAYS: If, during the examination period, there is a snow day, the examinations scheduled for that day will be taken during the next school day and all other examinations will be moved one (1) day.
