Students who are scheduled to take one or more Keystone Exams will receive a separate letter with specific testing information. The Algebra, Literature and Biology Keystone Exams will be administered on May 17th, 18th, and 19th, 2023. Only students taking a Keystone Exam will report to school. **Testing students will** remain in school for the entire day. All other students will not report to school. 12th grade students do not need to take Keystone exams. Please refer to the information below for the end-of-year schedule.

<u>FOR STUDENTS</u>: The attached final examination schedule will follow the schedule of classes you pursued during the second semester. There are two examination days, and two exams will be given each day. Final examinations are given in the following areas: English, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, World Languages, Business, and Health. In these subjects, all pupils will take examinations. <u>THE ONLY EXCUSE ACCEPTED FOR FAILURE TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION IS AN EXCUSE FROM A DOCTOR OR THE ADMINISTRATION</u>.

Students will remain in class for the duration of each exam.

<u>FOR STUDENTS</u>: The final examination schedule will follow the schedule of classes that you pursued during the first semester. The exception is that the four (4) blocks will be spread over two (2) days. Final examinations will be given in the following areas: English, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, World Languages, Business, and Health. In these subjects, all pupils will take examinations. Examinations will be administered in your regular classroom, supervised by the classroom instructor or an instructor designated by the administration.

THE ONLY EXCUSE ACCEPTED FOR FAILURE TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION IS AN EXCUSE FROM A DOCTOR OR FHS ADMINISTRATION.

AUTHORIZED STUDENT AREAS DURING FINAL EXAMS: During the examination periods, no students are to be in the halls or main lobby areas of the school. If you are not scheduled for an examination and must be at Freedom High School because of transportation constraints, you are to report to the cafeteria. Once you have reported to the cafeteria, you are to remain there until the end of the period.

TRANSPORTATION: During the final examination period on June 6th and 7th, the school buses will run at their regular times in the morning and will pick up students at the regular stops. At the end of the second examination period, school buses will take students home at 12:00pm. There will be no buses to take students home after the first examination session on each exam day. There will be no scheduled bus service on Thursday, June 8, 2023. Students who need to make up exams on Thursday should arrange personal transportation.

LUNCH: The last day for the cafeteria will be Monday, June 5, 2023.

BETHLEHEM AREA VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL STUDENTS: be Thursday, June 8, 2023, will be the last day for underclassmen.
