
Kindergarten and First Grade Graduation

Kindergarten Jumpstart

If your child will begin Kindergarten this next school year, we would like to invite him/her to an additional educational opportunity provided through our Kindergarten Jumpstart Program. Mrs. Schwarz will work with the new kindergarten students on familiarizing themselves with their kindergarten classroom and the school.

Kindergarten Jumpstart will run from July 19th thru July 23rd from 8:00 am to 12:30 pm. Snacks and lunches will be provided. Transportation will be provided for students living out of town. Please let the school know if your child will need transportation.

Driver's Education

Drivers Education Class will begin Monday June 7th and run for two weeks. Cost for the course is \$75.00 for in district students and \$150.00 for out of district. Students must have either a driver's license or permit before taking this course. Classes will be held from 8:30AM until 4:00PM daily (with the possibility of running later on driving days). The front door to the school will be open for student access. Please bring pencil & paper as the rest of the instructional material will be provided. Lunch will not be provided.

Each student will drive approximately 6-8 hours and observe at least 12 hours. Students will practice driving on dirt roads, residential areas, two lane highways as well as the interstate.
