Classroom Expectations

Our classroom will operate using the school wide behavior policy. The following rules will be in place to provide your student with a safe and supportive learning environment.

- 1. Show respect in words and actions for others and property.
 - 2. Follow directions.
 - 3. Keep your hands, feet, and school tools to yourself.
- 4. Use your ears to listen and raise your hand if you want to talk.
 - 5. Demonstrate safe behavior at school.

Rewards and Consequences for Behavior

If a student makes great choices throughout the day, they will earn a "Go Green" day. This color will be marked on the behavior calendars that are in the Take Home Folders. While green is a great color that students will be rewarded most often for good choices, a student can occasionally earn a pink or purple day as well. These colors will be given out when a student goes above and beyond to make our classroom a great learning place. Please do not be alarmed if your child does not display pink or purple each day. Green is great!

*If a student chooses not to follow classroom expectations, he/she must move their card and follow through with the consequences for their actions. The consequence for each color is as follows.

Purple	Outstanding Day!!! (Three Ranger Bucks, Pick from Treasure Box)
Pink	Great Choices!! (Two Ranger Bucks, One Treasure Box Point)
Green	Ready to Learn! (One Ranger Buck, One Treasure Box Point)
Yellow	Reminders Were Needed (5 Minutes off recess, discuss better choices)
Blue	More Reminders Needed (10-15 minutes off recess, discuss better choices)
Red	Too Many Reminders, Step on School Wide Plan (no recess)
Beyond Red	Refer to Office for Office Level Intervention
