



GENRE: Fiction




<u>SUMMARY:</u> Click, Clack, Moo: Cows That Type is an award-winning children's book by Doreen Cronin. Illustrated by Betsy Lewin, the Simon & Schuster book tells the story of Farmer Brown's cows, who find an old typewriter in the barn and proceed to write letters to Farmer Brown, listing various demands.

ASSIGNMENT:

- 1. Using the reading response map students will answer questions about the story.
- 2. Students will create letters to Farmer Brown from the cows with new demands and a thank you letter for the electric blankets.
- 3. Students will complete two word problems about Farmer Brown and his animals.


