
Fishbowl Question Search

Directions:

- 1. Print question sheet provided below.

 - To keep the materials long lasting, questions could be laminated, pasted to popsicle sticks, etc.
- 3. Have students pick questions from the bowl as they read.
- 4. Have student answer the questions based off of what they have read.
