Personal References: Personal references are not required, but they can assist the Committee when evaluating scholarship applications. The Committee encourages applicants to submit references, including one from a high school or college instructor. **A reference form is attached to this application** (you may make additional copies). References may <u>not</u> be submitted by relatives of the applicant, the applicant's parents or stepparents. Completed reference forms should accompany your completed application form.

Scholarship Committee: A committee composed of volunteers award The Flathead Education Foundation scholarships. The Scholarship Committee considers all complete applications, including supporting documents. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final and not subject to challenge.
