FLATHEAD POMONA GRANGE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

The Flathead Pomona Grange, a longtime agricultural fraternal organization, has set aside funds to be used for educational scholarships to <u>TWO</u> graduating seniors from any high school in Flathead County. Amount of scholarship: \$500 each.

CRITERIA

THE APPLICANT:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior in Flathead County
- 2. Must <u>fully</u> complete formal application. (Available from school guidance offices or career centers.) No substitute forms will be accepted.
- 3. Must submit three (3) letters of recommendation with application.
- 4. Must provide an official grade transcript with the application.
- 5. Must have at least a 2.25 cumulative grade point average.
- 6. Must be enrolling for the up-coming academic year in 1 of the following:
 - Vocational School
 - Four-year University or College
 - 2-year Community or Jr. College
 - Any other approved institution that would prove beneficial to the student in furthering his/her education and/or development of a future profession.
- 7. Must be enrolled in a sufficient number of quarter or semester hours at the time of entry into college to be considered a **full-time student**.
- 8. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend the Pomona Grange May meeting (first Monday in May at Eastside Grange Building) for a short presentation. Giving the scholarships is important to the Grange. This provides an opportunity for Grange members to briefly meet the scholarship winners.
- 9. Optional but recommended: Enclose a wallet-size picture with scholarship application
- 10. Applications which are incomplete or missing attachments, i.e., 3 letters of recommendation, transcript of grades, etc. will be disqualified.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

Selection of scholarship winners will be made by members of the Flathead Pomona Grange Executive Committee and a member of the Grange Scholarship Committee. The selection will be based on information submitted on the application form, letters of recommendation, and grade point average. Such things as Grange involvement, community involvement, scholastic ability, school activities, financial need and completeness of the application will be considered.

METHOD OF AWARDING:

Decisions as to the scholarship winners will be made on or before April 15th annually. <u>The awarded funds will be made payable to the school you are attending this Fall. It is your job to give our Grange representative a copy of registration receipt.</u> The funds will be transferred at that point.
