- 2. Explain how Pepe's knife functions as a symbol.
- 3. Describe the <u>setting</u> from the beginning of the story, on the farm / homestead where Pepe lives his mother and siblings.
- 4. Describe the <u>setting</u> at the end of the story, where Pepe ends up.
- 5. How does Steinbeck seem to be using setting symbolically?
- 6. Mama calls Pepe numerous animal names. List five.
- 7. During Pepe's journey, many different animals are mentioned. List five.
- 8. How, exactly, does Pepe's horse die? After losing his horse, how does Steinbeck characterize Pepe as an animal himself?
- 9. What is Steinbeck's <u>idea</u> in the three paragraphs where a mountain lion sits and looks at Pepe, who is wounded and sucking water from cloth, before the lion slinks off and men come into the scene?
- 10. Based on these patterns, and on *Of Mice and Men*, how does Steinbeck seem to use animals in his fiction?
- 11. Explain how this is a rite of passage story. In your opinion, does Pepe succeed in the rite of passage or does he fail? Why do you think so?
