Security officers placed in every feeder area

Most are retired police officers  
They do not stand out (on purpose) and are circulating among the school

Deputies still make random and unannounced visits to the school. They are checking for unlocked doors and other safety matters.

Drills: Flinn has completed 2 LOCKDOWN Drills and 2 FIRE drills this school year.

- safety meets with SOAR - first word of SOAR is SAFE
- checking on a shade for the front office where Leah is located for safety from an intruder
- need to have the bolt in the front office changed so that it can be locked from the inside
- night locks are being utilized and practiced

#### Student Attendance:

93.8%. This is down due to the excused absences granted during the threats at the middle and high schools. We expect to see this improve, especially with the awareness strategies we are using.

#### GSA Results:

Last year 3rd graders are now Flinn's 4th graders. They are showing to be at a higher level than last year. Fifth grade (last year's 4<sup>th</sup>) is showing somewhat behind and 4th is higher in ELA at Flinn than in the county. Fourth graders show neck & neck in Math within the county.
