Dear Parents of Advanced Placement Students,

Any student who takes two or more Advanced Placement (AP) courses in one school year will prepare and present an AP Inquiry project. Forestview High School is proud of this exciting new way in which students demonstrate not only their knowledge gained from AP courses but also the connections between them.

The grade for this inquiry project will be used as the student's final exam grade in all AP classes taken during the semester they present. Students will be required to create a multi-media presentation that integrates at least two AP disciplines. They will develop an essential inquiry question early in the semester and conduct independent research during the subsequent weeks to answer the question. The project culminates with a 10-12 minute presentation in which the inquiry question is answered and results revealed. Students are informed of the requirements of the presentation by the AP teachers. Also, all required and accessory documents can be downloaded and copied from the Forestview School website and you are encouraged to look at those with your child. Students will present the projects to their peers and teachers.

Students who are taking multiple AP classes are committing to a high level of learning and rigor. The administration and AP faculty considers these AP inquiry projects as an opportunity for your child to display their acquisition of knowledge from their courses.
