*\*\* The 2023-24 school year is a transition screening under ACPS's updated Local Plan for the Gifted. The previous screening cycle for students in grades 5-8 was Fall of 2022, so ACPS has opened a screening window for students in Grades 5-8 to be referred during two windows- the September 30 and January 31 windows during the 2023-24 school year. During the 2024-25 school year, students in Grades 5-8 will follow the updated referral screening windows with a deadline of January 31.*
