## **Telegram Announcing the Surrender of Fort Sumter**

**APRIL 13, 1861***The following is the transcript of the telegraph sent by Major Robert Anderson announcing the surrender of Fort Sumter.* 

SS. BALTIC. OFF SANDY HOOK APR. EIGHTEENTH. TEN THIRTY A.M. . VIA NEW YORK. . HON.S.CAMERSON, SECY, WAR, WASHN, HAVING DEFENDED FORT SUMTER FOR THIRTY HOURS UNTIL THE QUARTERS WERE ENTIRELY BURNED THE MAIN GATES DESTRAOYED BY FIRE. THE GORGE WALLS SERIOUSLY INJURED. THE MAGAZINE SURROUNDED BY FLAMES AND ITS DOOR CLOSED FROM THE EFFECTS OF HEAT. FOUR BARRELLS AND THREE CARTRIDGES OF POWDER ONLY BEING AVAILABLE AND NO PROVISIONS REMAINING BUT PORT. I ACCEPT TERMS OF EVACUATION OFFERED BY GENERAL BEAUREGARD BEING ON SAME OFFERED BY HIM ON THE ELEVENTH INST. PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF HOSTILITIES AND MARCHED OUT OF THE FORT SUNDAY AFTERNOON THE FOURTEENTH INST. WITH COLORS FLYING AND DRUNMS BEATING. BRINGING AWAY COMPANY AND PRIVATE PROPERTY AND SALUTING MY FLAG WITH FIFTY GUNS. ROBERT ANDERSON, MAJOR FIRST ARTILLERY, COMMANDING.
