

Before we view the movie adaptation of *Frankenstein, the Modern Prometheus*, take time to review the book.


CHARACTER → These are the beings who inhabit our stories.
For each character, describe → gender, relationship to Victor, words/phrases to define their characterization (personality), their fate. Put a star next to the character you think the movie will change the most.

Victor Frankenstein	The Creature
Henry Clerval	Elizabeth

PLOT → What happens in the story, the series of events.
Use these events to complete a simplified version of the plot diagram.

Victor builds the Monster a mate, then destroys it.
Victor builds the Monster, brings it to life, and flees.
Victor dies.
Victor is rescued by Walton.
Victor marries Elizabeth, whom the Monster kills.

The Monster kills William; Justine is blamed and executed.
The Monster mourns Victor and jumps off Walton's ship.
Victor sets off to find the Monster and kill him.
Robert Walton meets Victor, who tells his tale.
