Have each student answer and move their picture (or name on a sticky note, or write their name) under their answer.


Option 2: Cut off the pictures and put the options on opposite sides of the classroom. Have students physically move to their answer.

Talk about similarities and differences! Expand discussion if students are able (Ex. Where did you go shopping, What movies did you watch, etc.)


