Free Meals for All Students Ends June 30, 2022

The free breakfast and lunch meals made available for all students through the USDA during the COVID-19 pandemic will end at the conclusion of this school year. For the 2022-2023 school year, schools will be returning to the paid, reduced, and free meal structure that has been utilized in the past. This means all families will need to carry a positive balance in their children's school meal accounts when school begins next fall.

1. Complete an Application for Free and Reduced Meals

Complete the 2022-2023 meal eligibility application with registration materials this summer on the Starmont website. If you do not have access to internet or a computer, you may request a copy of the application from any of the secretaries or from the business office once school registration has opened.

If you have completed a meal eligibility application prior to July 1, 2022, your household will need to complete a new 2022-2023 application after July 1, 2022, for the next school year.

2. Pay Off Negative School Lunch Balances

If your student has a negative lunch account balance, we encourage you to pay that as soon as possible and then begin depositing money into your student's lunch account to prepare for the 2022-2023 school year.

3. Budget for the Cost of School Lunches

Families can start depositing money into their student's lunch account through the RevTrak payment portal to prepare for the cost of school lunches next year.
