

Qualification for participation in the selection process includes the following:

- ✓ Applicant must be a graduating senior in Spring of 2024 and **must be a resident** of Freeborn County. The applicant **must be enrolled** at a Freeborn County High School (Albert Lea, Alden/Conger, Glenville/Emmons) or a **Freeborn County resident** attending either Blooming Prairie High School, NRHEG, or United South Central High School.
- ✓ Applicant must be accepted or in the process of acceptance to an accredited college or University.
- ✓ Applicant must be majoring in an agricultural related program.
- ✓ Applicant must submit one letter of recommendation. The letter writer cannot be a relative of the applicant.

This scholarship is not an academic or needs based scholarship. This scholarship is given in appreciation of a student's commitment to agricultural or home economics.

The scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to the student who meets the above qualifications. The scholarship will be awarded based on the decisions of the committee personnel. The decisions of the committee are final and are not subject to alteration or review.

Transcripts from the first semester of post-secondary education must be received within 12 months of completion of the first semester.
