Your Graduation Requirements

- Due to the change of our daily schedule to a block schedule during your junior and senior year, the graduation requirements will be different for each graduating class from the class of 2019 to the class of 2022. Your graduating class of 2020 will be required to earn 52 credits in order to graduate.
- In addition to earning credits to graduate, students must meet or exceed credits in each of the following subject areas (See table)

• • Course Information

- "Prerequisites"
 - Make sure you have met the requirement to take a class & that it is offered for your grade!
 - If you have registered for a class and don't meet the requirements, you will be removed from the class.
 - For example, you need to take Art Foundations or Design Fundamentals before taking other art courses.

• • AP, CIS, Honors

- AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)
- CIS = College in the Schools (rank/GPA requirements)
- Accelerated = Placed according to test scores (placement made for you)
- *See registration guide for specific requirements.

• • What if I Fail Classes?

 Failing one or two classes each semester will mean that you will not graduate on time.

 Counselors will help you make a plan for credit recovery! It is up to you to seek us out if you need help.

• • Credit Recovery Options

- Summer School
- After school credit recovery (APEX)
- Re-take the class (if there is room in your schedule)

 All course requests must be submitted into Infinite Campus by Tuesday, January 17th by 8am.

 Turn in your Registration sheet to GPS advisor when complete or by January 17th.

• • Things to Remember!

 Classes with an A & B take two spots (Spanish 2A and Spanish 2B).

 If the class is not on the registration form - it is not open to 10th graders and you can not take it.

• • Pre-Loaded Courses

You will see some courses pre-loaded in the Infinite Campus (Portal).

If the classes are there, you do not need to add them and should not delete them.

• • How Do I Register?

- Enter course requests from your Registration Form into the Infinite Campus Portal.
- Be sure the classes you register for match the classes on your Registration Form.

• • Registration Forms

 Select courses – Check the box in front of each class you are selecting. You should mark 14 boxes and then list 4 alternatives.

 Be sure to have your signature and your parent/guardian signature.

• All 10th grade course options are arranged by areas of interest.
