1	Good quality <u>3-ring binder (1-2") or notebook</u> <i>Previous students have really liked the "Five Star Flex 1 inch Hybrid NoteBinder" (pic on right)</i>	
5 Dividers	<u>Colored tab subject dividers</u> to either use for your portfolio and/or your regular 3 ring binder.	
1	Zipper pouch to store supplies (3-hole punched heavy-duty Ziplock bags work) <i>You can choose the style. Heavy-duty is best</i>	
2 packages	Loose-leaf filler paper (If you spend extra and get the reinforced holes, you'll be glad.)	
1 pack of 4 dry erase markers	Dry Erase Markers <i>(thick style)</i>	
2 or more	Pens (a variety of colors is helpful)	
12	Pencils	
1 pack (at least 3+)	Colored highlighters
