MJ Community,

It was great to see our community this week at both the PTO Picnic and Curriculum Night. A frequent refrain I hear from our parents and caregivers typically involves gratitude for the good work that goes on here and that their students are happy to come to school each day. I want to also express my gratitude to you as a community, our students come to school each day excited and ready to learn.

As I spoke briefly about last night, as part of my entry plan, school staff and the community voiced a need for more consistent approaches to student expectations and behavior. This coincides with a finding from the district's equity audit. One of my goals this year is to collaboratively establish or reaffirm and implement core values that reflect the collective vision of teachers, students, and community members. This work would culminate in the development of a school wide community core values and norms that inform the behavioral expectations and rubric.

Medical documentation of a required screening from your child's primary care physician can be provided to exempt a student from school-based screenings. Additionally, if you wish to opt your child out of a required health screening, please notify the school nurse by October 12, 2023.

Fourth graders have been exploring the concepts of multiples and factors. We determined that the factors of a given number will share factors with its multiples. For example, the factors of 100 are *also* the factors of its multiples, e.g. 200, 300, 400. On a smaller scale, the factors of 8 are also factors of 16, its multiple. As we move into subsequent units on division, knowing the factors of a given number will be a helpful tool for problem solving.


