

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS FOR CURRICULUM REVIEW CYCLE

On even numbered years (95-96), the Dickinson Public Schools would look at one core curriculum area: e.g. math, science, social studies and language arts. On odd numbered years (96-97), the Dickinson Public Schools would look at one or more elective curriculum area: e.g. health, physical education, fine arts, vocational, counseling and library.

Technology is not considered a curriculum area. However, each curriculum review would include consideration of how technology can help the achievement of curriculum goals.

When the core area is under review, specific attention must be given to strategies and content for all students. Also, the core area review will have responsibility for establishing the staff in-service focus for the following academic year.

On the third year following a core curriculum area major review, a revisitation will be scheduled. The purpose of the revisitation is to check progress and to update curriculum concerning changes occurring since the major review.

Curriculum review is an ongoing, continuous process that is accomplished through standards alignment and identification of gaps and repetitions. The curriculum will be reviewed yearly by teachers but emphasis will occur using the following review cycle.
