- Completion of this form does not guarantee selection. Invitations to submit Candidate Information Packets are extended to students who:
 - are Sophomores or Juniors.
 - have a cumulative **weighted** Grade Point Average of at least 4.3.
 - have completed at least one full semester at Gaston Early College of Medical Sciences.
 - have not been assigned ISS or OSS for the school year previous to induction.
- Students will be notified of acceptance by March 17.
- There will be an induction ceremony in the auditorium and you will receive a certificate.

Once inducted, students will uphold the following standards to maintain membership:

Standard	Requirement	Penalty
GPA	4.3 Weighted	Members who fall below the GPA requirement will be placed on academic probation. Members who fall below for two consecutive semesters will be dismissed.
Standards of Conduct	No ISS or OSS No violations of the Student Code of Conduct No violations of the law	ISS or OSS will result in dismissal. Violations of the Student Code of Conduct will be given a written warning notification. A hearing may be requested. If a member is involved in another violation, the member may be considered for dismissal. Can result in dismissal.
Service Hours	Completion of at least 30 hours	Members who fail to earn the required service hours will be dismissed. Seniors who fail to earn will not wear the cord at graduation. **Community Service (non-paid) performed with other organizations counts toward NHS requirements.
Meeting Attendance	NHS members are required to attend at least half of the monthly meetings.	Members who miss more than three general membership meetings will be issued a warning. Members who miss more than half of the meetings will be dismissed.

If you are dismissed or resign for any reason, you are no longer an active member and will not be re-considered for membership.

Only NHS members in good standing are eligible to wear NHS emblems at graduation.
