
Ms. Rabold's Syllabus

Homework/ In Class Assignments:

- There will be homework for every section and possibly every night. I will be collecting
- and grading homework almost every night. Students will need to complete their homework assignments to perform well on the in class assignments (warm up questions) that they will be completing every section for correctness.
- Homework is on completion and in class work will always be on correctness. I will only give points to the homework I check.



- Late Work Policy: On the day that I check or collect the homework and you do not have it done, you have one day to turn it in for half credit (5 out of 10 points).
- You cannot work on homework in class. Must be done out of class. If a student tries to complete homework during class, they will receive zero credit.
- Homework must be completed when I check it/collect it or it will be considered late.
- You must show work on your homework to receive credit!
- Copying any online resources or another student's homework is considered cheating.
 This will result in zero credit for you and who you copied as well as a referral to the office and call home.
- **Unexcused Absence** = Zero for that day (Homework, Test, Quiz etc.).
- **Hive**: If you are in need of extra help on a topic you may ask for a Hive pass. This is not an everyday pass. Only when needed.
- **Extra Credit:** You will have one extra credit opportunity a quarter.

Grading Scale:

- In class Assignments: 25%
- **Test:** 40%
- Quizzes: 30%
- Participation: 5%

Expectations/ Classroom Procedures:

- Come in on time with your calculator, paper, pencil, and math binder.
- **Absolutely no phones out.** I should never see your phones out during class. I will take your phone if I see it out and deliver it to the office.
- Once everyone is quiet and ready, we will go over any homework questions you may have from the previous night.
- After going over the homework I will assign your warm up questions on correctness.
 During this time there is no talking and you will be working by yourself. There will be times I will allow students to work together but I will tell you ahead of time. You will have a time limit on the warm up questions.
- Once finished, I will collect and we will go over the questions.
- After the warm up questions, we will start the day's activity or lesson.
- I will give a syllabus out every chapter. I will have homework, quiz dates, and test dates on the syllabus. The syllabus is flexible and can move around. I will give at least a week notice before a test to give students time to prepare. I will put the syllabus on my website.

Responsibility:

- Students are responsible for turning in their own work. If you are turning in late work the next day, you must turn it in. I will not be asking you for the work.
- If you are absent, it is your responsibility to go into the bin and grab the notes you missed. It is also your responsibility to get the notes from a classmate to copy down.
- If you are absent you have one day to make up the absent work. For however many days you are absent is the amount of days you have to turn in the work.



- If you miss a test or quiz you must schedule a time as soon as possible to make up the assessment.
- Hall Pass/ Bathroom breaks: Students must go to the bathroom before class. I teach bell to bell and do not want students missing any information. I understand situations will come up so there is a three pass quarter rule. Each student can go to the restroom during class three times a quarter. If they have not used their passes by the end of the quarter, students will receive 5 extra credit points for each time not used. After three bathroom breaks, students must stay in the classroom and find another time to use the restroom. Only one student can leave the room at one time.

- Students are responsible to be on time. If you are not in the class before the bell rings, you are tardy.
 - 1st Tardy Warning
 - \circ 2nd Tardy-2nd Warning and a call home
 - \circ 3rd Tardy- Office Detention
 - $\circ\quad 4^{th}$ Tardy- Office Detention and call home
 - o 5th Tardy- 2 Hour Friday School
 - o 6th Tardy- 3 Hour Friday School
