Overview: Geometry introduces geometric reasoning as a method for problem solving. In this course, you

will explore the properties of geometric figures such as triangles, quadrilaterals, and other polygons. You will make constructions using pencil and paper and you will practice using mathematical language to express ideas and justify your reasoning. Some important geometric ideas and included the construction of the construc

ideas such as symmetry, similarity, and trigonometry will also be examined.

This course culminates in the taking of the NYS Geometry Regents Exam in June...this exam is

worth 20% of your Final Course Average.

#### **TESTS/QUIZZES:**

Tests: Will always be announced with adequate time to prepare. Test Days are Mondays & Fridays.

Quizzes: May be announced or unannounced any day of the week.
