Get to Know Me One-Pager created by Kimberly Brill DUE DATE: Thursday, August 30th by the end of class

What is it? A one-pager is a single page (11" x 17") of white paper that connects your thoughts and ideas creatively. You may use your own colored pencils or markers or use the colored pencils available at Stations 1-4 in the classroom. You can also use the stencils on the art table near the door as well as the rulers at each station. You may want to trace some images on your Chromebook, which is fine. In addition, you can use your Chromebook to look up details about the quotes, songs, etc. The purpose of this one-pager is to introduce yourself to our class in a way that we can know you and work together this school year and beyond. You should make a first draft/sketch before creating your final product. Your work will be displayed, so create something you will be proud of. We will work on this for 2-3 days in class, and the rest will be completed on your own.

<u>Directions and what to include in your one-pager:</u>

□ Write your first and last names somewhere on the nage (this can be done creatively)

write your mist and last names somewhere on the page (this can be done creatively.).
Include a picture of yourself (drawn or printed) somewhere on the page.
Include a border that reflects something that represents you.
O This can include words, pictures, symbols, quotes, etc.
<u>Create</u> & <u>answer</u> one meaningful question about yourself that most people get to know about you easily.
O This should not be yes or no question.
 This questions and answers should represent obvious/simple questions about yourself.
<u>Create</u> & <u>answer</u> one meaningful question about you that most people DO NOT get to know about you easily.
O These should not be yes or no questions.
 This question and answer should represent deeper questions about yourself.
Draw or create THREE - FIVE images that represent you. Remember the purpose is allowing your teachers and
classmates to get to know you.
Create TWO goals for the school year. (These DO NOT have to be ELA related).
Include TWO interesting quotes or thoughts (not song lyrics) which inspire you.
O Include quotation marks and name the author of the quotes/thoughts.
Include TWO song lyrics which represent you.
O Include quotation marks, song titles, and the name of the artist.
Be purposeful and neat.
O Your entire page should be filled with these elements.

- If you find you have extra room, repeat any of the above steps/ elements.
- No space should be blank.
- Choose to represent yourself in black & white or in color, but do so purposefully (not because you ran out of time).
- Your name, date, and class period should be on the BACK of this one-pager assignment sheet and turned in with your completed one-pager.
