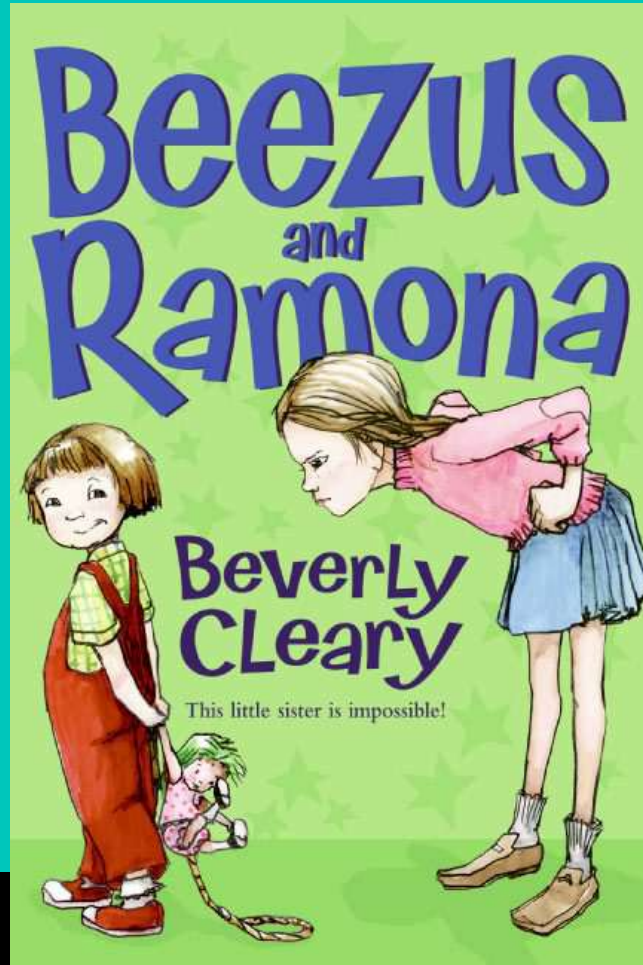

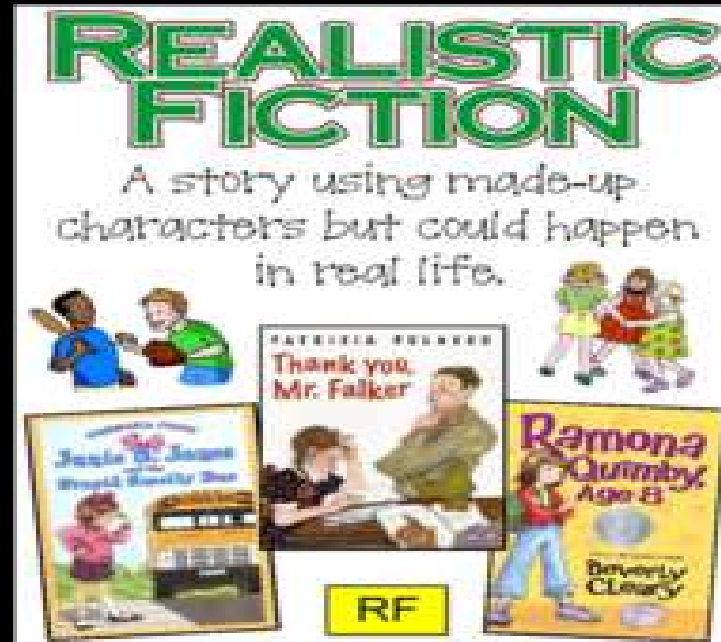

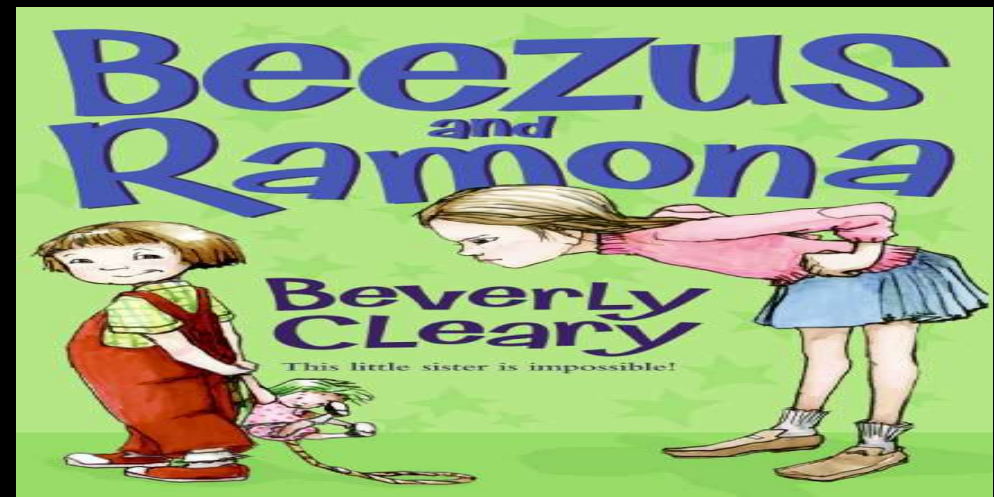
# GENERE
