

4 Year Grad Rates – Class of 2023






Students in Special Education – Cohort View




5-Year Grad Rates for Students in Low Income Households








5-Year Grad Rates Students who are Unhoused

We propose maintaining the goal of increasing the 5-year graduation rate for students who are English Learners, students in Special Education, and students from low income households to at least 90%.

We believe that although we have not met 90% graduation for these groups, we are in partial compliance because we are out performing similar groups at the state level and putting significant resources into support for our students most at risk of not graduating.

Why?

Students today have a vast array of options available to them after their high school career. Whether it's college, technical programs, the military or going into the workforces the key is developing a plan.

- All our students will complete a High School and Beyond Plan by the end of their senior year.
- The process starts in the 8th grade, with components beginning as early as the 6th grade.
- $\circ~$ We have also added the following components to plan during their senior year:
 - Acceptance letter to college, the military, trade/technical training, and apprenticeships.
 - Verification of industry certification.
 - Verification of employment.
