Required Texts:

Grade 1: Pete the Cat: Too Cool for School by James Dean

Grade 2: Henry and Mudge: The First Book by Cynthia Rylant

Student Requirements:

 Read a minimum of 20 minutes a day. (Color in a square on your calendar each day.)

• Read required grade level text and complete the graphic organizer paper.

Students are expected to read a minimum of 20 minutes each day during the summer. The required text for their grade is listed above and the graphic organizer should be completed using information from the book. Students should try to read the required text on their own. Please assist your child by reading to or with them if the book is challenging. If needed, please use the Suggested List (see attached) as a guide when choosing books in addition to the required reading text. Students should color in a picture on their calendar for every day that they read. A list of fun literacy activities to try is included but these are not required.

Students will return their signed calendars and completed graphic organizer paper to their teacher on the first day of school. Students that return all of their work completed will get their photo taken and displayed on the Reading Wall of Fame!

Summer Literacy Activities to Try

- Draw a picture that could be included in your book
- · Read aloud to a family member or friend
- · Make a fort with blankets and read in it
- Read something other than a book today (comics, magazine, cereal box, etc)
- Go outside and read (don't forget to put on sunscreen!)
- · Act out an event from a book and make the character come to life
- · Read in your favorite spot
- Send a postcard to someone and recommend a good book
- Draw a picture of your favorite character
- Try reading some recipes and then make one to eat!
- Read with someone and take turns reading pages or sentences (Reader/Leader!)
- · Draw a new cover for a book you read
- · Read to your pet
- · Read to your stuffed animals
- Call up (or video chat) a friend or relative that lives far away and read to them
- Make an audio recording or video of yourself reading. Use a sound effect when it's time to turn the page! Then play it back and follow along.
- · Read in the dark with a flashlight
- · Read while eating ice cream (try not to drip it on your book!)
- Go to the library to read some books and take some home
- Make up a story when you are in the car, take turns adding parts to the story
- Read on a swing
- · Make predictions about the book before you read it
- Tell someone why would or would not to be friends with the character in your book
- Look up information about the author or illustrator of the book you read
- Read at least 5 books by the same author
- · Write or tell someone about a different ending for the book
- · Watch a movie or show that's based on a book, then compare them
- Draw a picture about your book with chalk outside
- Draw the setting of your book with chalk outside
- Read a craft book and then create something (or just make a craft that somehow relates to your book)
- Go to the bookstore to look at some books; it's fun even if you don't buy any!
