Explore Science with Albert

In chapter 38 Ally says, “And then it hits me like a boulder.” Boulders are formed when solid rock breaks apart into smaller pieces, this is weathering & erosion. You can model this erosion at the beach. Make a land mass or incline. Use your hand to make a river bed. Place stones along the river bed. Pour water where the riverbed starts. You just moved rock with erosion!
