Language Arts

We are excited about our integrated Reading series that includes reading, writing, speaking, listening, spelling, handwriting, and grammar. <u>Spelling</u>

After taking a pre-test on Monday to test prior knowledge, students will bring home a new list to be studied for our test on Friday. These words will be written in the student planner AND a list will be sent home to study on Mondays. Days for testing are subject to change, due to shortened weeks.

Sight Words

Students are required to say and spell all 10 sight word lists by the end of 2nd grade. We will be working on these throughout the year.

Handwriting

We begin the year reviewing printing and learning slant print. Cursive writing generally begins in January. **DO NOT** attempt to teach your child cursive; we will all be learning the Peterson Directed Handwriting System together IN CLASS!

Math

The Everyday Mathematics series is a challenging program stressing problem solving, number awareness, mental math, use of multiple strategies, and math skills in our everyday lives. It may take some time before you feel comfortable with the vocabulary and activities, but the children will remember similar activities from first grade. Some nights there will be a small homework assignment referred to as a Home Link. These are for you and your child to complete together. They typically cover a concept practiced in class and should be returned to school the next day. *HINT: The answers to Home Links are on the back of the "Family Letter" sent home at the beginning each Unit.*

Social Studies

We will begin the year with Social Studies, learning about our neighborhood, community, and map skills.

Health

The Food Pyramid, healthy habits, and the five senses are just a few of the topics we will cover.

ASSET Science

We will complete two hands-on science modules this year, "Changes" and "Insects." Each module includes a variety of interesting, thought-provoking, and enriching activities.

Tests

We will be sending a completed/graded test packet home on Friday (to be signed for homework) and turned in on Monday.

Absences
