

Q1 Overall, how satisfied are you with your child's progress during the COVID-19 school closure?


Q2 Overall, how satisfied are you with the work provided to your child during the school closure?







Q5 While schools were closed and your child participated in Distance Learning, which were the most important to you as a parent? Please rank them in order from the most important to the least important.








Q8 How comfortable are you in sending your student to school this fall?


Q9 If we are required to limit the number of students in a school building at one time, which option would you prefer? Please rank in order of your preference, #1 being your first choice.


Q10 If bus transportation in the fall is limited, are you able to transport your child to school?
