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## **Artist Trading Cards**

Students create 6 artist trading cards. Each card must express something about themselves. I have included my video introduction, the template they could print (or create their own), the requirements handout, and my turn-in sheet and rubric (which I will make digital when I assign this online). This is always a big hit. We usually culminate the lesson with a trading day. Unfortunately, that step would have to be eliminated, but they could always trade on their own at a later date.



### **Required Resources:**

- Printable template (optional- students can also draw their own 2"x3" rectangles, use index cards, or even cut rectangles from cereal boxes)
- Scissors
- ANY other drawing/collage/painting supplies they have on hand
