GRADING POLICY: CHORUS/CHORALE

Choral Department grades will be determined by the following factors:

Individual/ensemble performance: balance and blend, intonation, technique, musicianship, written work, effort, and attitude.

Public Performance: any performance for an audience of any size at any level.

General Grade Breakdown per marking period:

Daily participation grade: 10 points (approx. 400 points) District-Required Quarterly Writing Sample: 15 points (2) Quarterly Bell Ringer Notebook Checks: 10-15 points per check Bell Ringer Quizzes (1-2 per marking period): 20-40 points each Sight-Singing Testing (Chorale/Musicianship ONLY): 10-30 points each *Pre/Post-Test: 50 points **Concert: 100 points per concert *Pre- and Post-Tests are only given in the 1st and 4th marking periods.

**Typically no concerts in the 1st and 3rd marking periods (subject to change).

Daily Grade Rubric

Each student can earn up to 10 participation points per day. To earn the full 10 points, the student is expected to

- Participate in full in all vocal and class activities (including written work)
- Apply all singing concepts and skills
- Show exemplary work and behavior at all times, including following of class rules

The following will result in a lowering of the daily grade:

- Use of a cell phone during the class period
- Food/drink in class (other than water)
- Disrespectful behavior toward the teacher or another student
- Not having assigned folder/music/pencil/bell ringer notebook for class
- Doing other work, talking, or otherwise not participating in rehearsal activities
