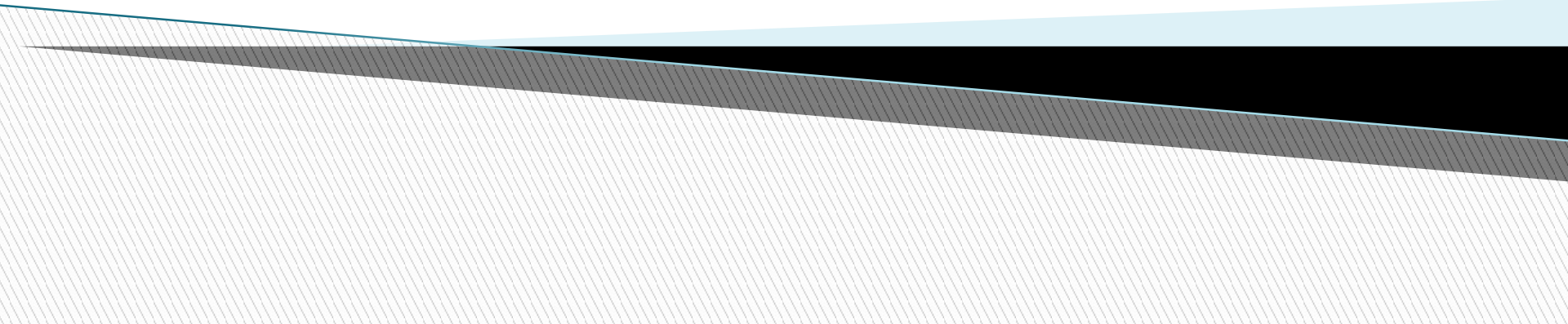

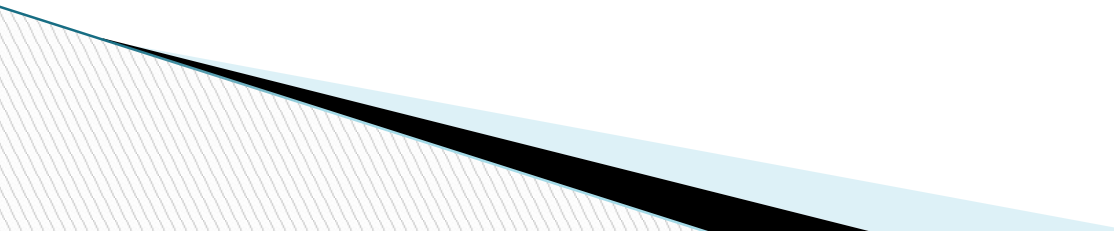


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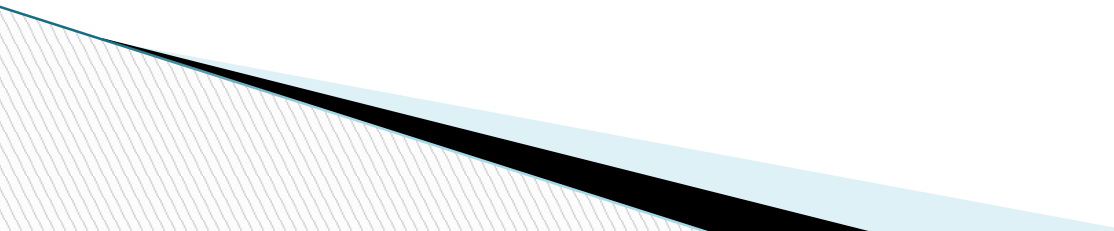
- ▶ The total number of credits you should have earn from 9th grade (6 to 8 credits), and the total credits could have earned now are:

Core courses required to graduate from high school so far includes:

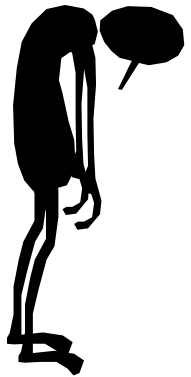
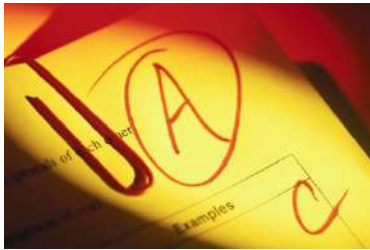
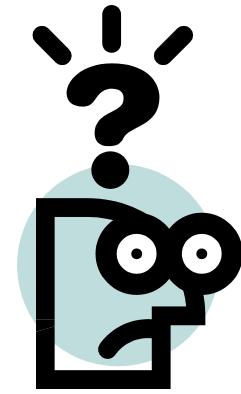
- ▶ Health & PE



- ▶ Pass 75% of coursework




