SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES (All items must be addressed and included in submission packet)

1. Scholarship applicants must be graduating high school seniors. In 2021, preference will be given to students who are the first member in a family to attend a college, university, or trade school.
2. Applicants must provide a transcript showing fall semester senior year grades and must have a 2.5 GPA or higher.
3. Applicants must provide a copy of their FAFSA (or describe financial need in an essay).
4. Applicants must provide at least one reference letter.
5. Applicants must provide a one page essay demonstrating school/community leadership.
6. Applicants must attend a college, university, or trade school located within the state of Michigan.
