You will write a biography of this god or goddess and turn in the biography to me along with a bibliography telling me where you found your information. You can use the [easybib.com](http://easybib.com) link on my website to assist you in your work.

On presentation day you can bring to school a costume to cover your school clothes to put on in the classroom.

You will need an information sheet about which god or goddess you are to hold while half of the class tours the classroom. Then we will switch.

Your information sheet should include details about your chosen god or goddess but not their name. This is where the fun begins. As students tour the classroom and read your information sheet you come to life. You tell us a story about your god or goddess. Then on a worksheet the tourists will write down who they think you are.

Here is a list of some better know Greek gods and goddesses and if you choose a lesser known god or goddess just give me the information beforehand so I can have it on hand.
