Exam Notes:

- 1. Full Year Classes (Algebra 1 Year-long, AP/IB Lit) will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
- 2. Students in first semester classes who take an End-of-Course Exam will have their exams during the EOC testing window. The main EOC administration days will be Wednesday, 1/6 and Thursday, 1/7. Makeup EOC exams will be administered 1/11-1/15. Students in these classes MUST attend their regularly scheduled class period on exam days. Teachers will administer a final assessment in these classes that is sufficiently weighted as a major grade. We will not disrupt the school and others taking exams for early dismissals. Staff members will NOT inform students or parents that the class has ended and their attendance is not required.
- 3. Exams must be comprehensive and challenging and should be sufficient in length to fully cover the 90 minutes allocated for the exam.

Exam Rules:

- 1. The exam schedule is to be followed to the letter. NO EXAMS WILL BE ADMINISTERED EARLY.
- 2. Every class at Greer High School will administer a 90 minute exam that covers the content of the curriculum taught and provides sufficient rigor and challenge. No class or student is exempt from exams.
- 3. Students who do not take the final examination will receive a zero. There will be no early dismissals during examinations exceptions only for medical, dental, funerals, and extreme emergency as excused by the building principal.
