### Senior Exam Notes:

- Seniors are to attend all classes for which they are scheduled through Thursday, May 20. Students who have previously taken an AP or IB exam will have a graded culminating activity during their regularly scheduled exam period.
- Teachers of seniors who have taken an AP or IB exam will be required to obtain an exam average by taking the third quarter and fourth quarter numeric grades, determining the average of the two quarters, and inserting the average into the exam column on the report card.
- **No final exams should be administered early. No exceptions.**
- Senior exams are for seniors only. **In classes where there is a mix of seniors and underclassmen, underclassmen must wait until their exams are administered the following week.**
- Final Exams will cover the content of the curriculum taught and provide sufficient rigor and challenge. No class or student is exempt from exams.
- Students who fail to take the examination will receive a zero.
- Graduation will be held at the Bon Secours Wellness Arena on Tuesday, June 1 at 8:00 am.

#### **Exam Notes:**

- Full Year Algebra Classes will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
- Students in second semester classes who take an End-of-Course Exam (US History, English 2, Algebra 1, and Biology) will have their end-of-course exams from May 21 – June 4.

- Teachers of underclassman who have taken an AP or IB exam will be required to obtain an exam average by taking the third quarter and fourth quarter numeric grades, determining the average of the two quarters, and inserting the average into the exam column on the report card.
- Students who have previously taken an AP, IB, or EOC exam will have a graded culminating activity during their regularly scheduled exam period.
- We will not disrupt the order of school and those administering and taking exams for early dismissals. Early dismissals will only be considered for medical, dental, funerals, and extreme emergency.
- **No final exams should be administered early. No exceptions.**
