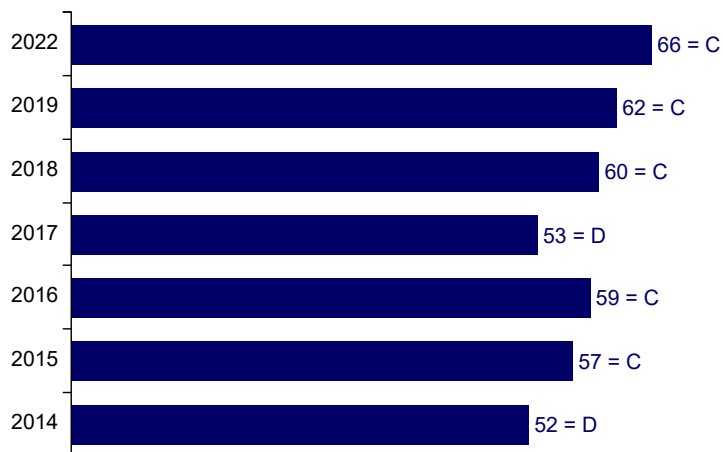

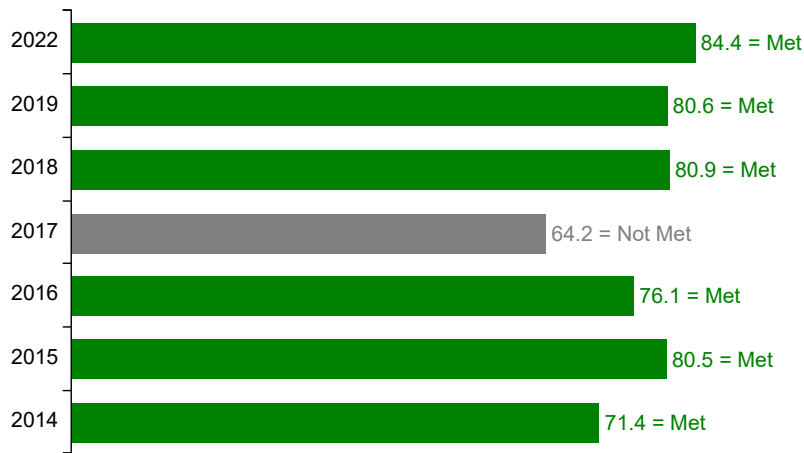

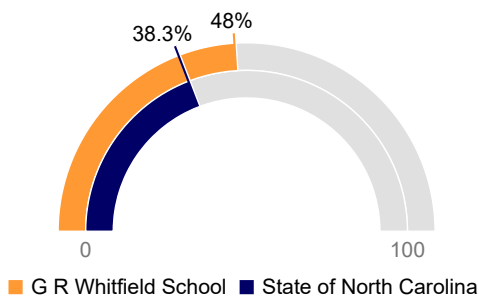

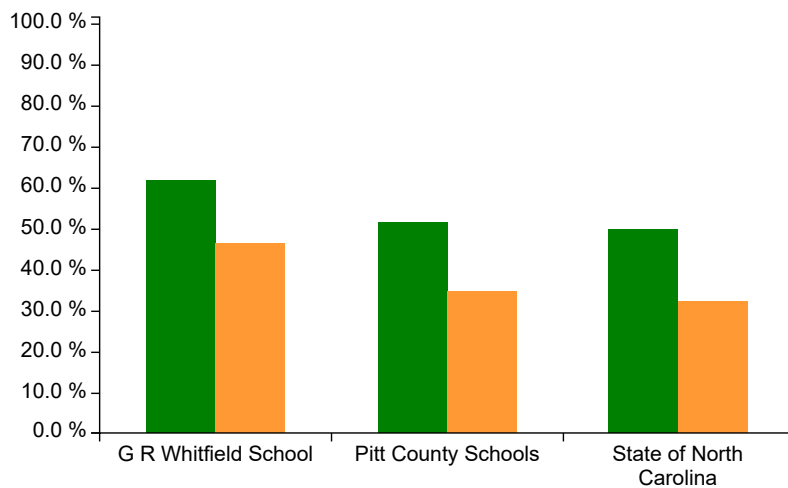

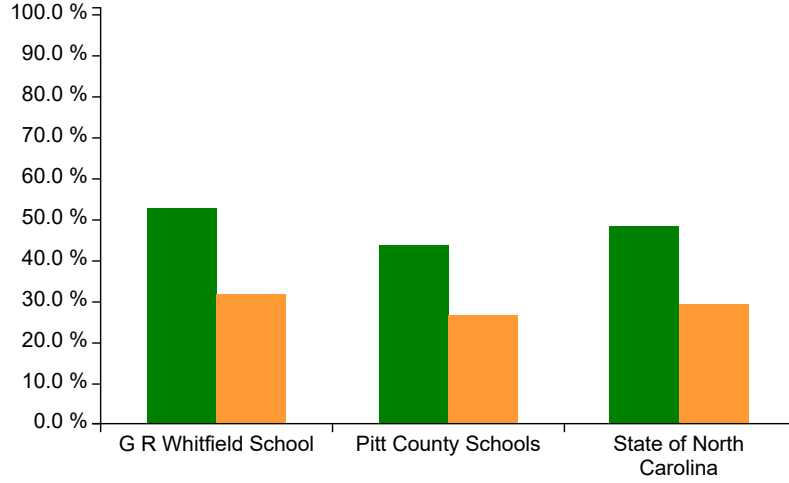

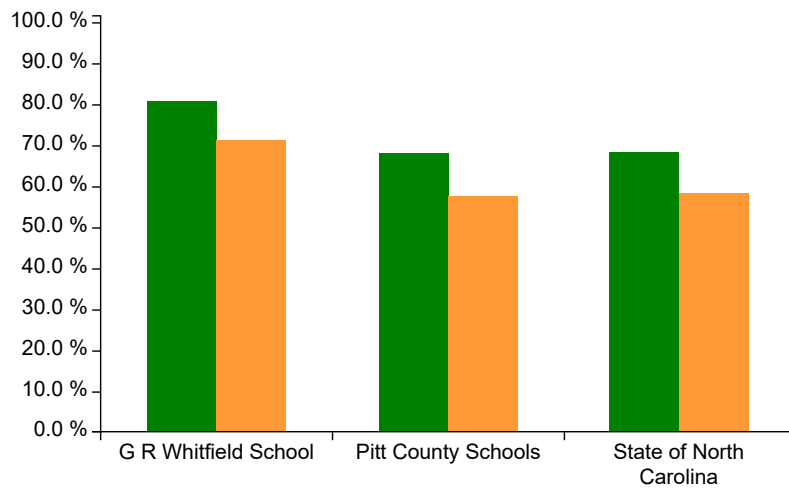

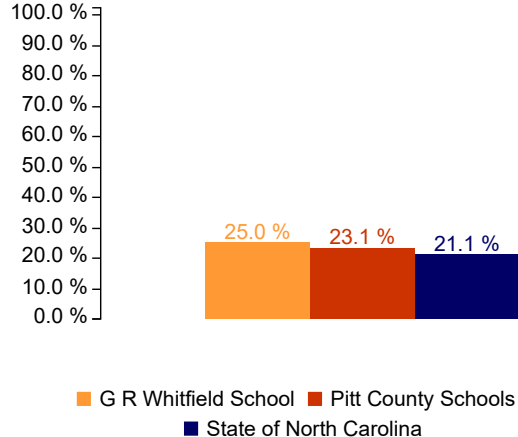

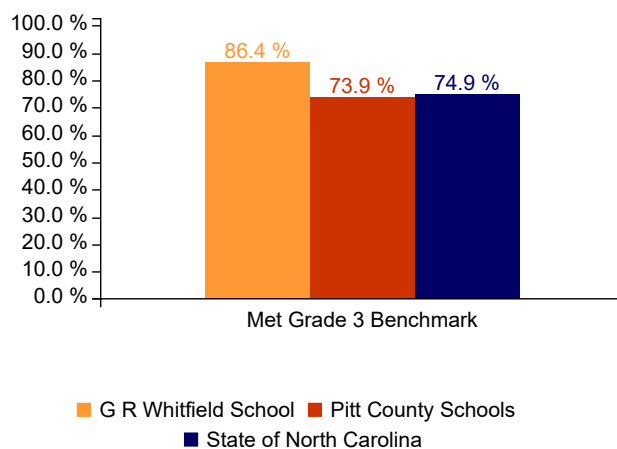

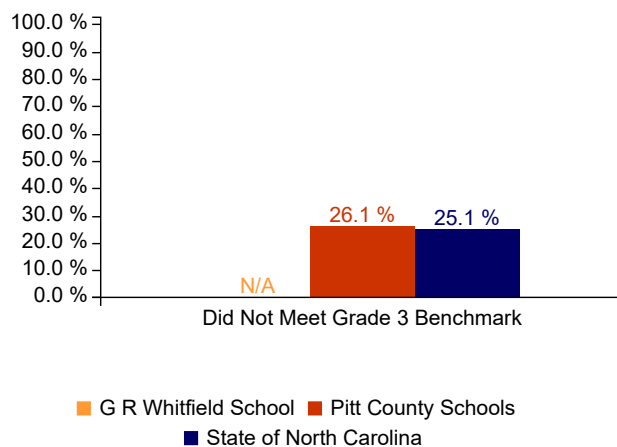

Percentage of students participating in state mandated standardized testing.

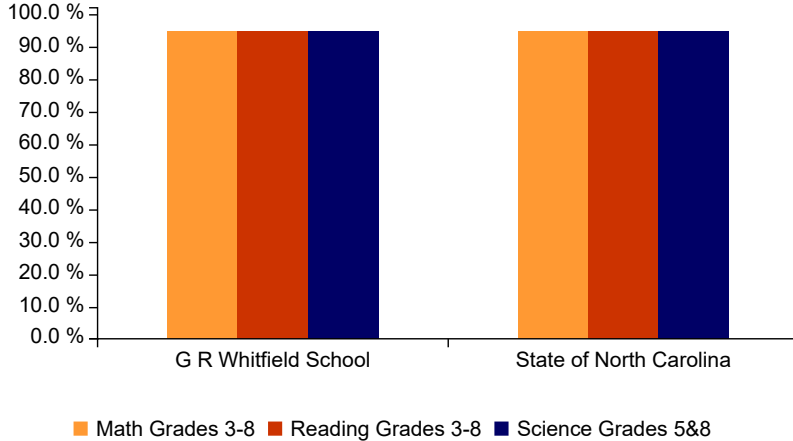

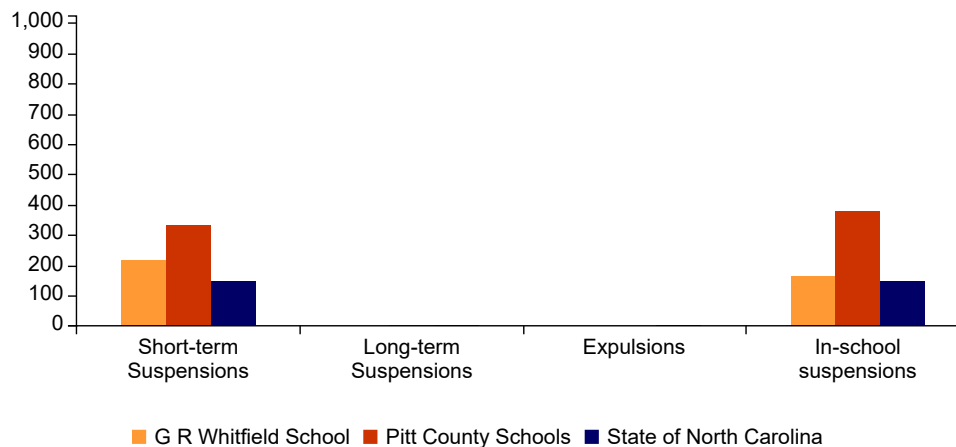
